<p>Q5: Case Study: Misuse of State Treasury Funds — An Arthashastra Perspective</p> <p>In the kingdom of Avanti, the king sanctioned a fixed amount from the Rajakosha (state treasury) for the welfare of forest-dwelling communities, as advised by Acharya Kautilya. The funds were strictly meant for providing food, clothing, and medical aid to tribal settlements located near the frontier areas.</p> <p>As per administrative procedure described in the <i>Arthashastra</i>, the release of funds required the joint authorization of the Amatya (Chief Administrator) and the Kosadhyaksha (Treasury Superintendent). However, due to urgency, the Amatya signed several blank authorisation orders and entrusted them to the Kosadhyaksha for disbursement.</p> <p>The Kosadhyaksha filled one such order in the name of Devadatta, a court attendant who was loyal to him but was not a member of the beneficiary tribal community. With the help of the Panyadhyaksha (Chief of Trade and Commerce), the funds were encashed through a merchant guild in the capital city.</p> <p>Later, it was discovered by the Gudh Purusha (secret spy) that the money never reached the intended tribal beneficiaries. Instead, the amount was diverted for personal use and political favours within the court. The welfare scheme failed, leading to distress among the frontier communities and loss of trust in royal administration.</p> <p>Upon investigation, the king realised that the misuse occurred due to negligence, breach of duty, and violation of Raj Dharma, as clearly warned against in the <i>Arthashastra</i>.</p> <p>Questions: Q. 5: (a).
