
### GLBIMR Women Cell Organized Expert Talk on PCOS Awareness | ETS

The winners of the challenge were: Manvendra Singh Bhati, Mritunjay and Deepshikha.








### GLBIMR Conducted Expert Talk on Category Marketing with Ms. Aakanksha Gupta | ETS

Through active participation, the session ignited a passion for inquiry and academic excellence, enriching their learning experiences and equipping them for leadership roles in research and beyond.














### GL Bajaj Volleyball Team Clinches Championship at Annual Inter-College Sports Event


### Expert Talk on Understanding the Modern Tourist | ETS


