
Mahakumbh Amrit Vichar 2025 at GL Bajaj




Battle Royale Madness: BGMI Showdown at GLBIMR!


Fostering Education & Sustainability: GLBIMR Signs MoU with Gram Pustakalaya





UMANG: Spreading Joy and Kindness at GLBIMR!






Strokes of Bharat: A Celebration of India's Culture Through Art


GLBIMR Participated in PRME Chapter India Meet 2024



Reducing carbon footprint in transportation and logistics

As supply chains become more complex and globalized, transportation and logistics contribute significantly to carbon emissions. The logistics sector, particularly freight transport, accounts for a large share of global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Reducing the carbon footprint in this sector is essential for sustainability, cost efficiency, and compliance with environmental regulations.

Key Strategies to Reduce Carbon Footprint

- **Optimizing Transportation Networks**

Route Optimization: Using AI and data analytics to determine the most efficient routes reduces fuel consumption and emissions.

Consolidation of Shipments: Combining multiple smaller shipments into one full-load truck or container helps reduce the number of trips.

Intermodal Transportation: Utilizing a mix of rail, road, and sea transport can lower emissions compared to relying solely on trucks.

- **Using Low-Emission and Alternative Fuel Vehicles**

Electric and Hybrid Trucks: Adoption of battery-electric and hybrid trucks reduces reliance on fossil fuels.

Hydrogen-Powered Vehicles: Hydrogen fuel cells offer zero-emission alternatives for heavy-duty transport.

Biofuels and Renewable Diesel: These can replace traditional fossil fuels and significantly cut emissions.
