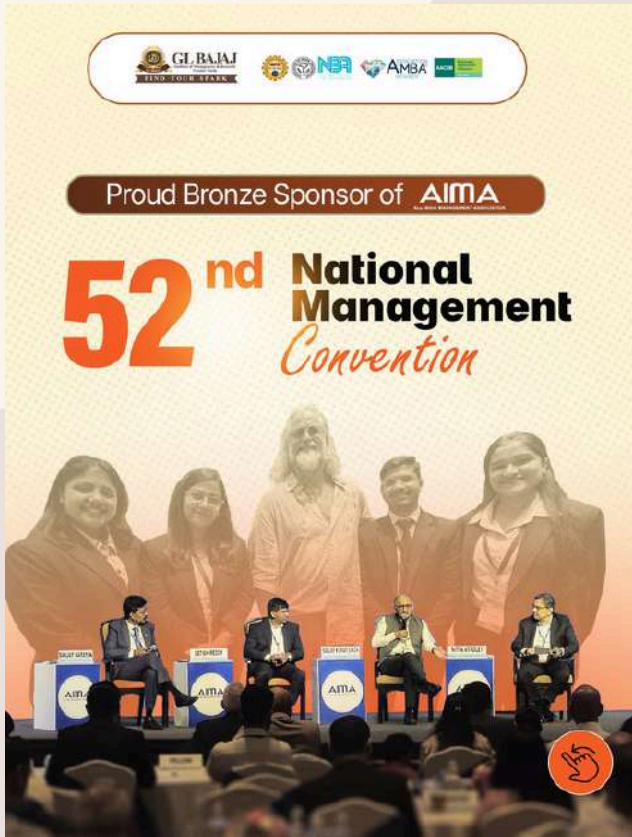

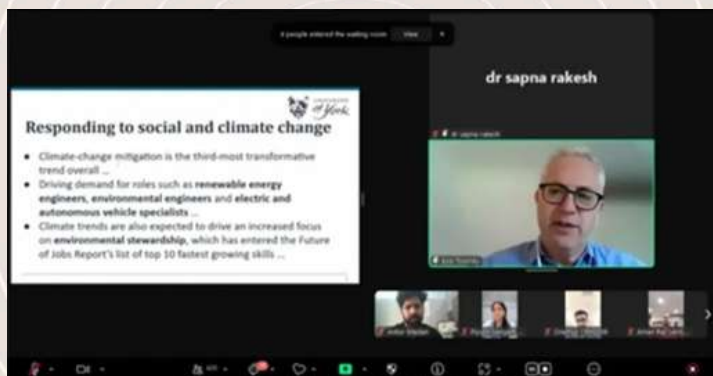
GLBIMR Hosts an Enlightening Global Talk Session with Dr. Bob Townley | GTS

Overall, the Coca-Cola industry visit served as an informative and motivational experience.

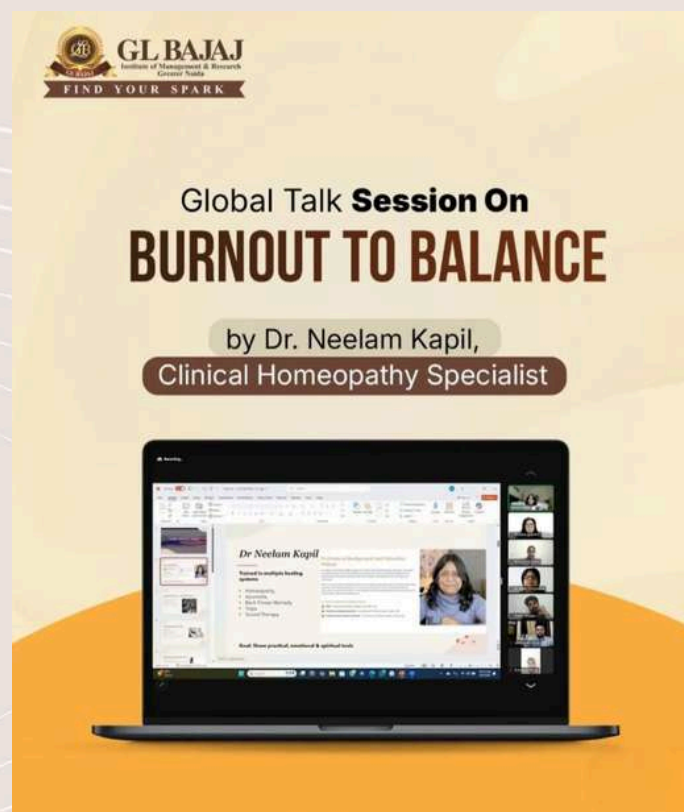


GLBIMR Organizes an Enlightening Global Talk with Dr. Neelam Kapil | GTS

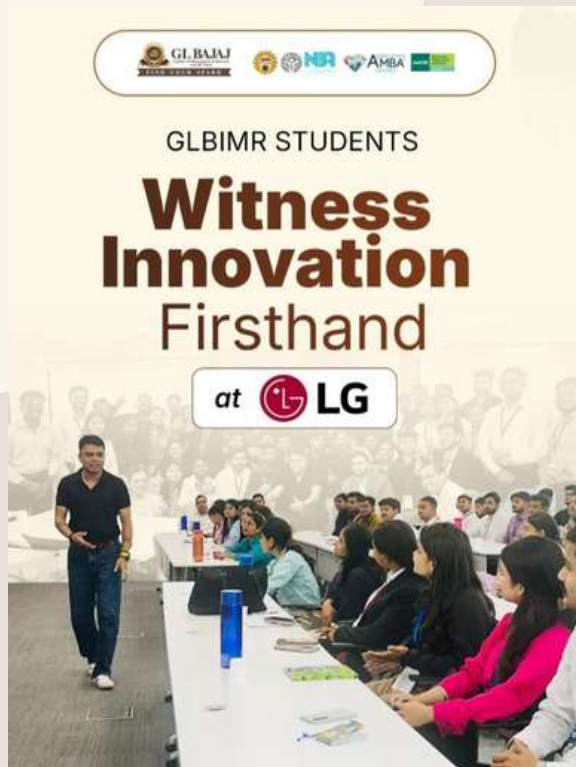

GLBIMR Fosters Experiential Learning through Industry Visit to LG Electronics



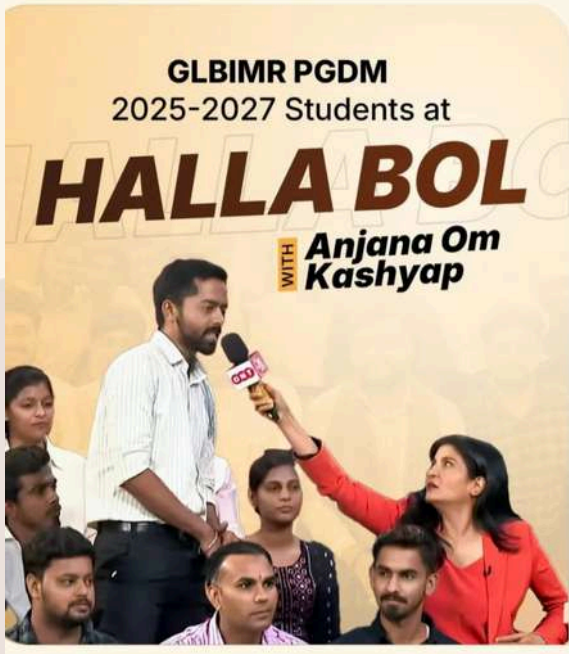

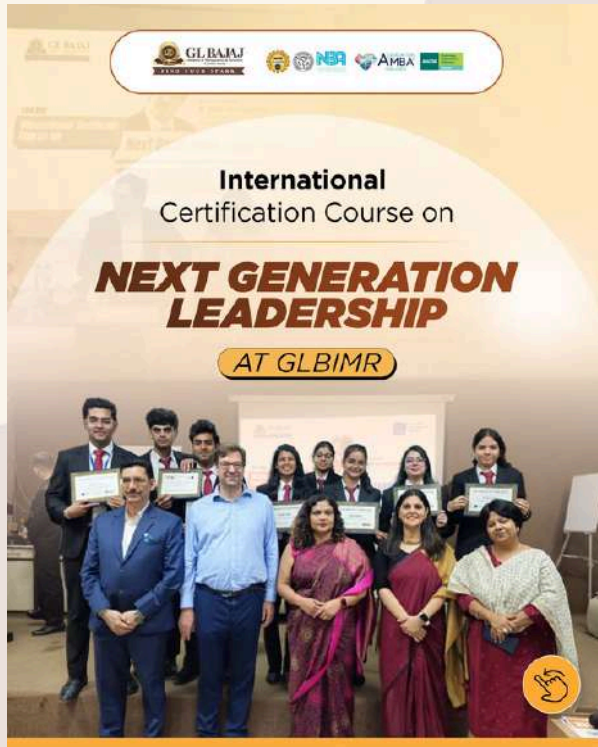

GLBIMR PGDM Students Gain Global Exposure through International Immersion Program at UCSI University, Malaysia



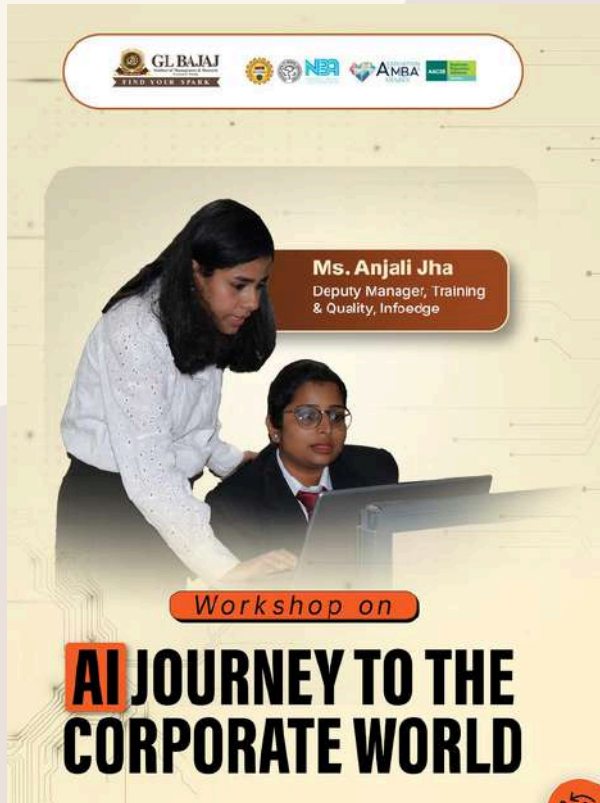

GLBIMR Hosts “Tazurba 2025” – Inter-Institute Summer Internship Project Competition

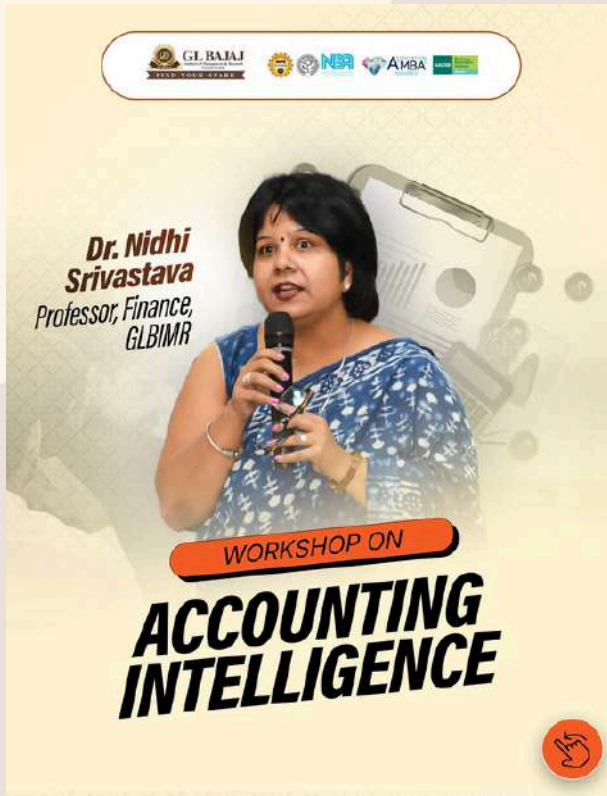

GLBIMR Organizes Two-Day Workshop on “Accounting Intelligence” to Enhance Financial Acumen



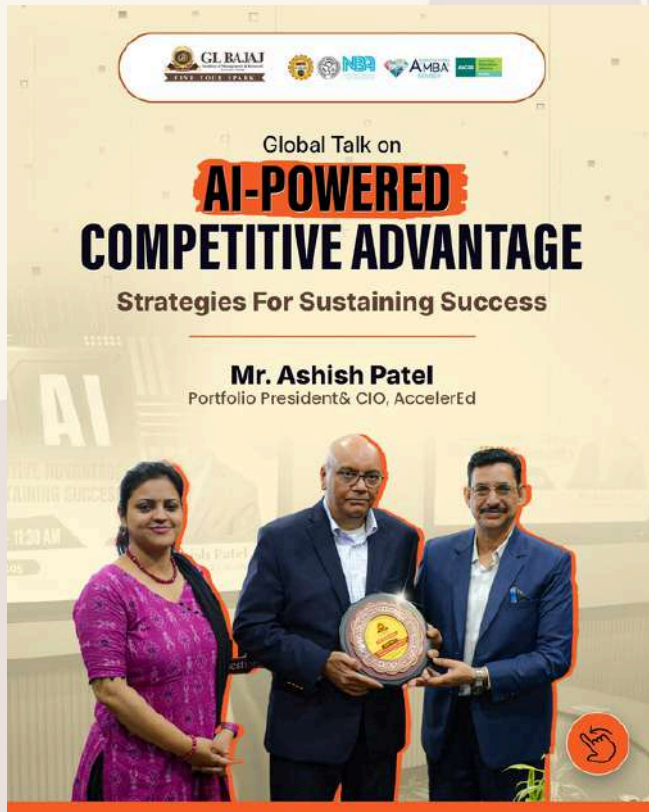

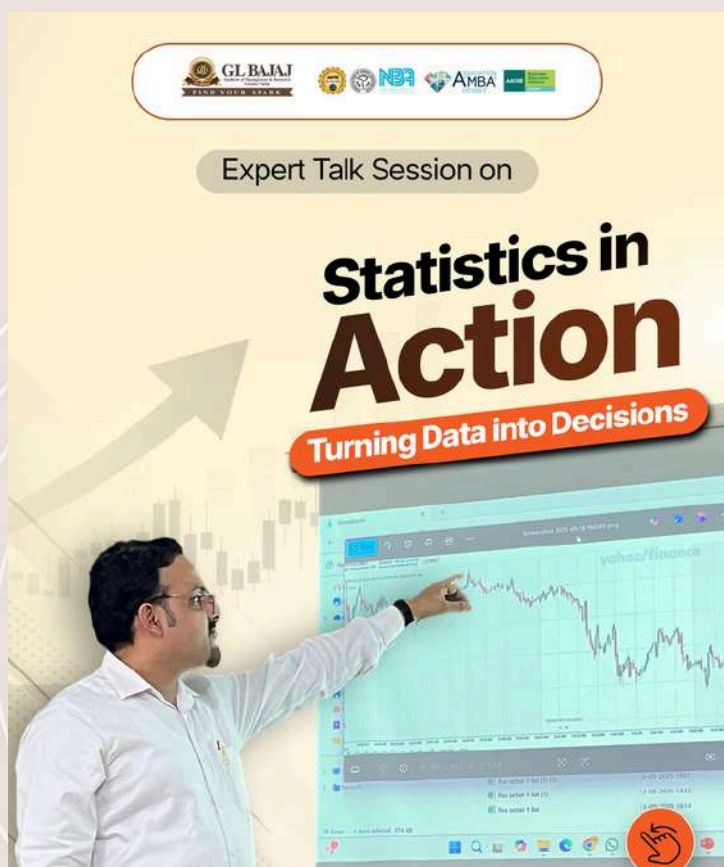
GLBIMR Hosts Insightful Industry Expert Talk on “Statistics in Action” | ETS

GLBIMR Leads by Example with E-Waste Donation Drive for a Sustainable Future

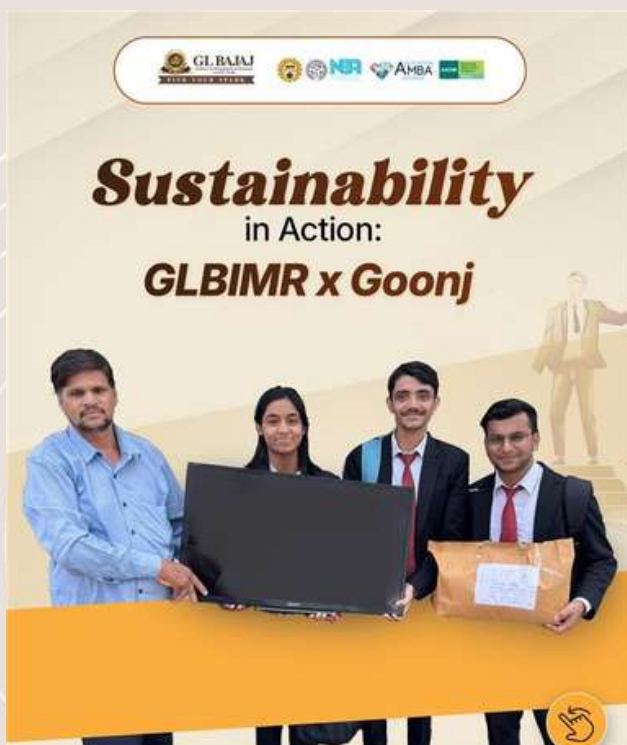
At GL Bajaj Institute of Management & Research (GLBIMR), we believe that even the smallest actions can create meaningful change.

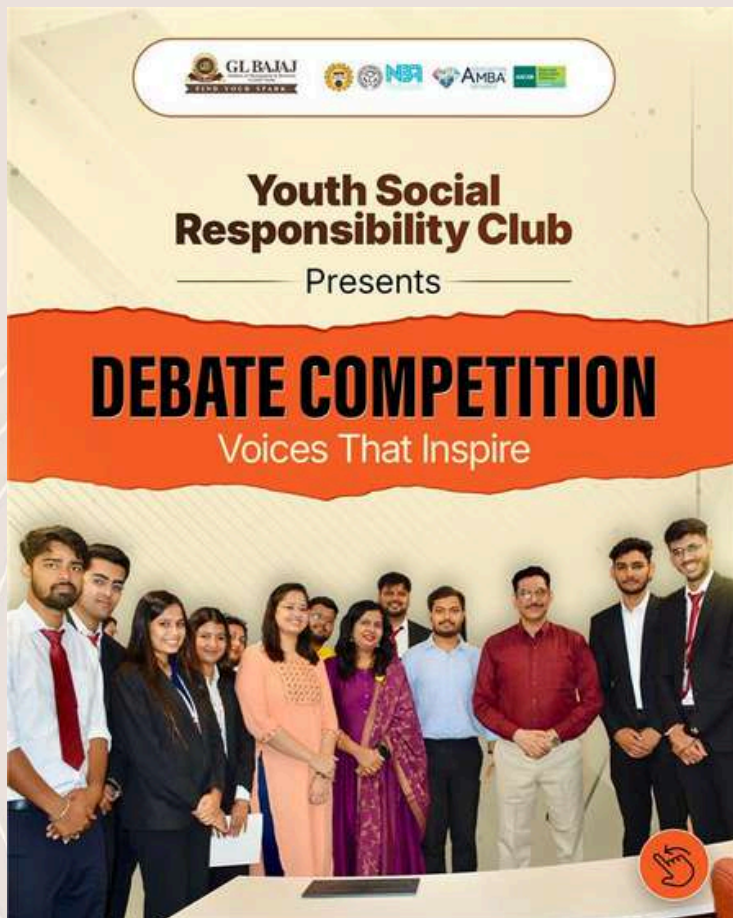


GLBIMR YSR Club Fuels Intellect and Expression with “Vichaar Battle 2025”

GLBIMR Art & Culture Club Showcases Creativity and Entrepreneurship through “GLB Haat”

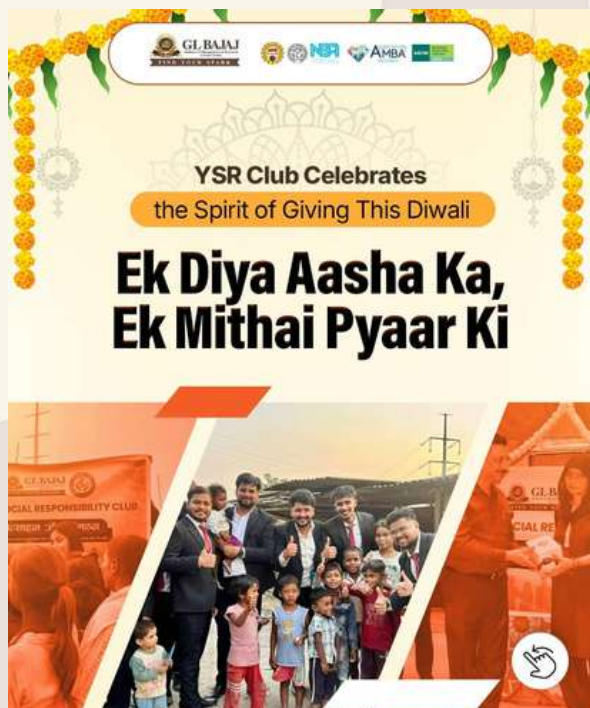

GLBIMR Sports Club Energizes Campus Spirit with Thrilling Tug of War and Cricket Matches

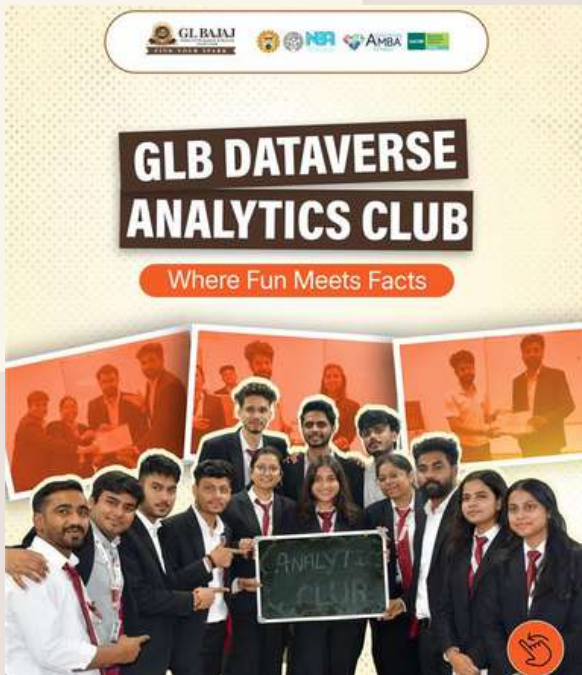

The event concluded with appreciation for all participants and winners, making Jumble Joy 2025 a successful and enjoyable experience on campus

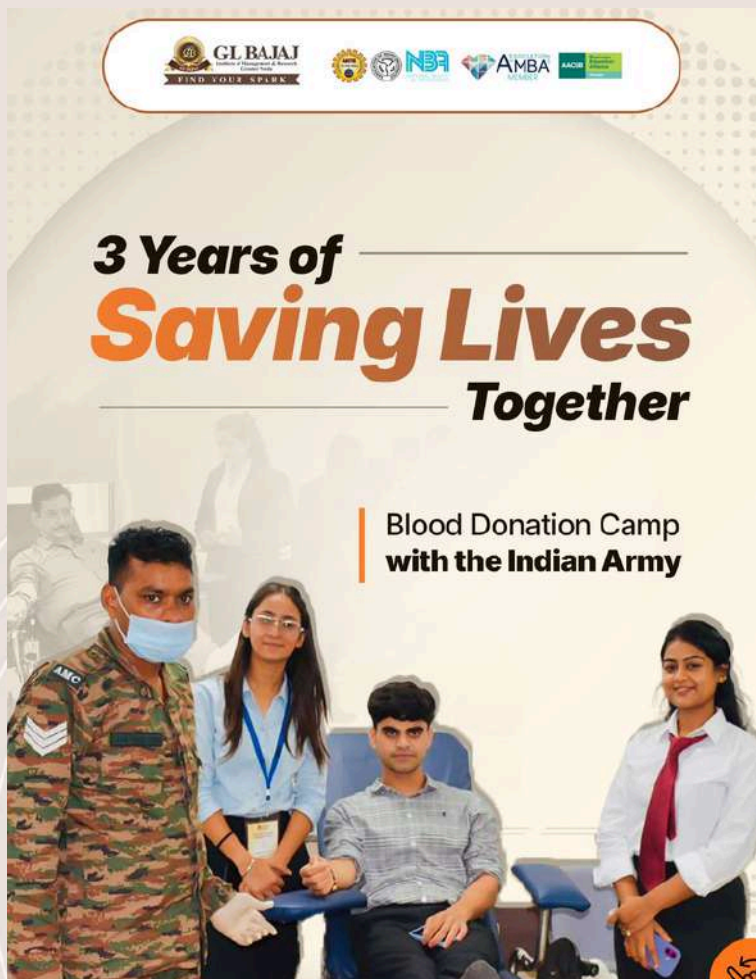


GLBIMR YSR Club Honors Heroes with Blood Donation Drive for Army Personnel

The event concluded with appreciation for all participants, making Business Housie 2025 an enjoyable and educational experience on campus.

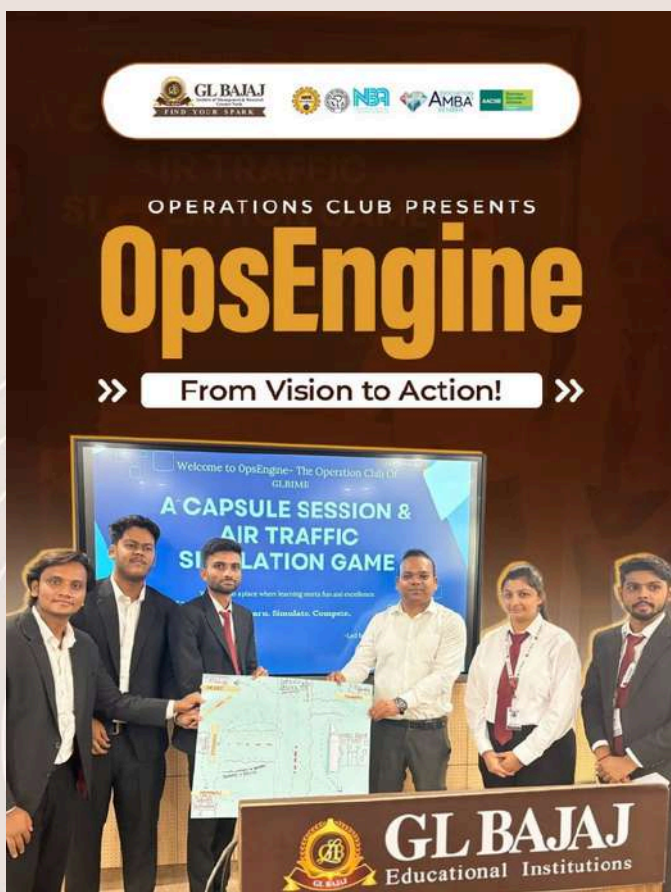


GLBIMR Operations Club Conducts Engaging Capsule Session and Air Traffic Simulation Game
